Euclid Juvenile Diversion Program

The Euclid Juvenile Diversion program is available for first time Euclid youth offenders that have committed a misdemeanor level offense in the city. If offered this option, the youth must admit their guilt to the offense and appear before our Euclid Juvenile Magistrate. If the orders of the court are satisfied, the charges are expunged from the youth's record.

The diversion program has two components: community service work and group counseling. Each diversion day is split up into these two-hour sections. Community service consists of litter pick up, neighborhood flyer distribution, snow shoveling, raking and various cleaning duties. The group counseling is provided via contract with Berea Children's Home. All juvenile diversion participants must satisfy both requirements. In addition, the Magistrate may order a drug/alcohol assessment, anger management classes and/or a variety of other programs.

In addition to these court orders, if unruly charges are filed on a juvenile, the parent(s) are required to participate in six (6) weeks of parenting counseling to help them redirect their child's behavior.

In 2010, a decision was made by Cuyahoga County to allow juveniles to waive first-time traffic offenses and simply pay a fine thus diverting any diversion or court appearance. This decision along with the closing of our Juvenile Court Intake Office in East Cleveland and subsequent staffing changes may impact our diversion numbers.
