Euclid Juvenile Diversion Program


The Euclid Juvenile Diversion program is available for <u>first time</u> Euclid youth offenders that have committed a misdemeanor level offense in the city. If offered this option, the youth must admit their guilt to the offense and appear before our Euclid Juvenile Magistrate. If the orders of the court are satisfied, the charges are expunged from the youth's record. In some cases, we're hearing second offenses if they are still at the misdemeanor level and they are a different offense than the original.


For 2011, the program is being enhanced by an additional grant courtesy of the Ohio Department of Youth Services through Cuyahoga County. This program is focusing on interventions at the middle school level with youth that commit assault or assault-related offenses. The interventions include expanded counseling for the entire family and communications workshops performed twice a month at Euclid Central Middle School.










VICTIM ADVOCATE REPORT VICTIMIZATION STATISTICS May, 2011


RECEIVING SERVICES

(Statistical categories for more than one Occurrence)




INTERVENTIONS
