Euclid Juvenile Diversion Program

The Euclid Juvenile Diversion program is available for first time Euclid youth offenders that have committed a misdemeanor level offense in the city. If offered this option, the youth must admit to the offense and appear before our Euclid Juvenile Referee. If the orders of the court are satisfied, the charges are expunged from the youth's record. In some cases, we're hearing second offenses if they are still at the misdemeanor level and they are a different offense than the original.
