

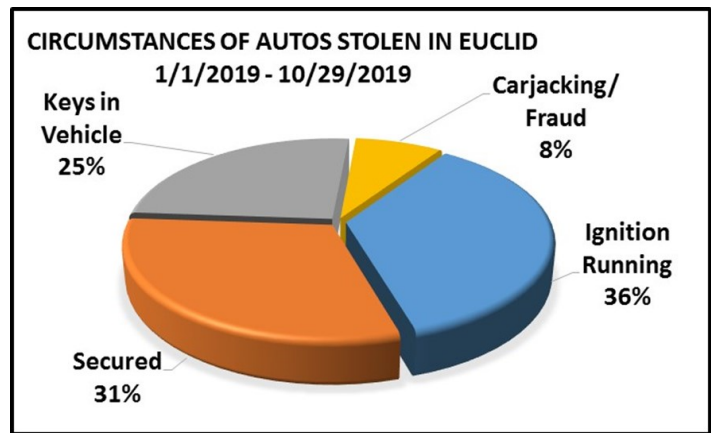

PREVENT THEFT FROM AUTOMOBILE

The single most important thing you can do to prevent auto break-ins is to never leave anything in your vehicle. Smash and grab thieves are looking for the smallest things left behind in your car! Many theft from auto reports state the victim left items visible in the car, or did not lock the doors. Always lock your car doors, even in your driveway!

- Leave valuables at home.
- Put valuables and items in the trunk before you reach your destination.
- Never leave ANYTHING visible inside your vehicle: loose change, wallet, purse, cell phone and charger, lab top, iPad, MP3 players, clothing, GPS, CD's, DVD's, etc.
