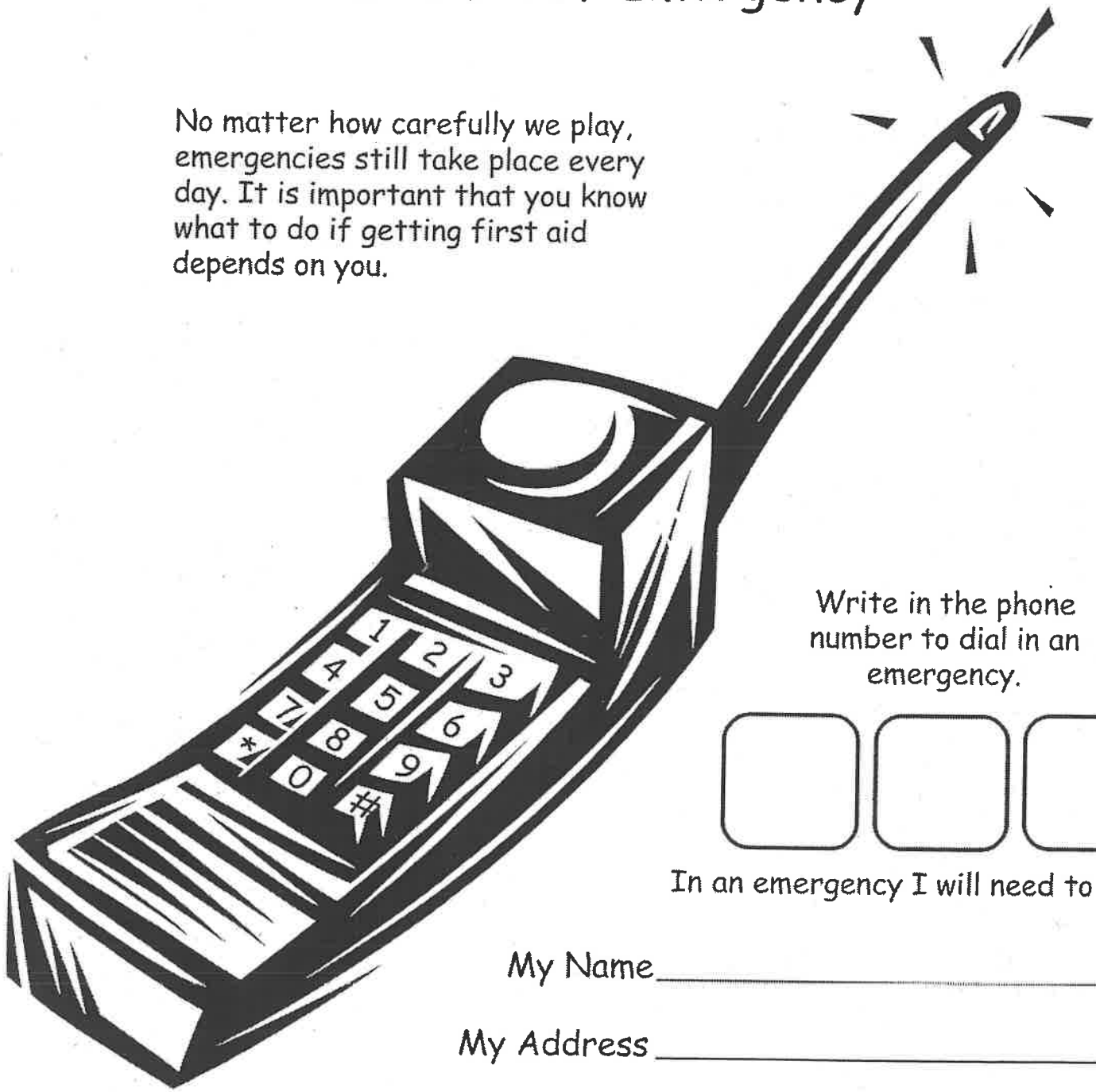


In Case of Emergency

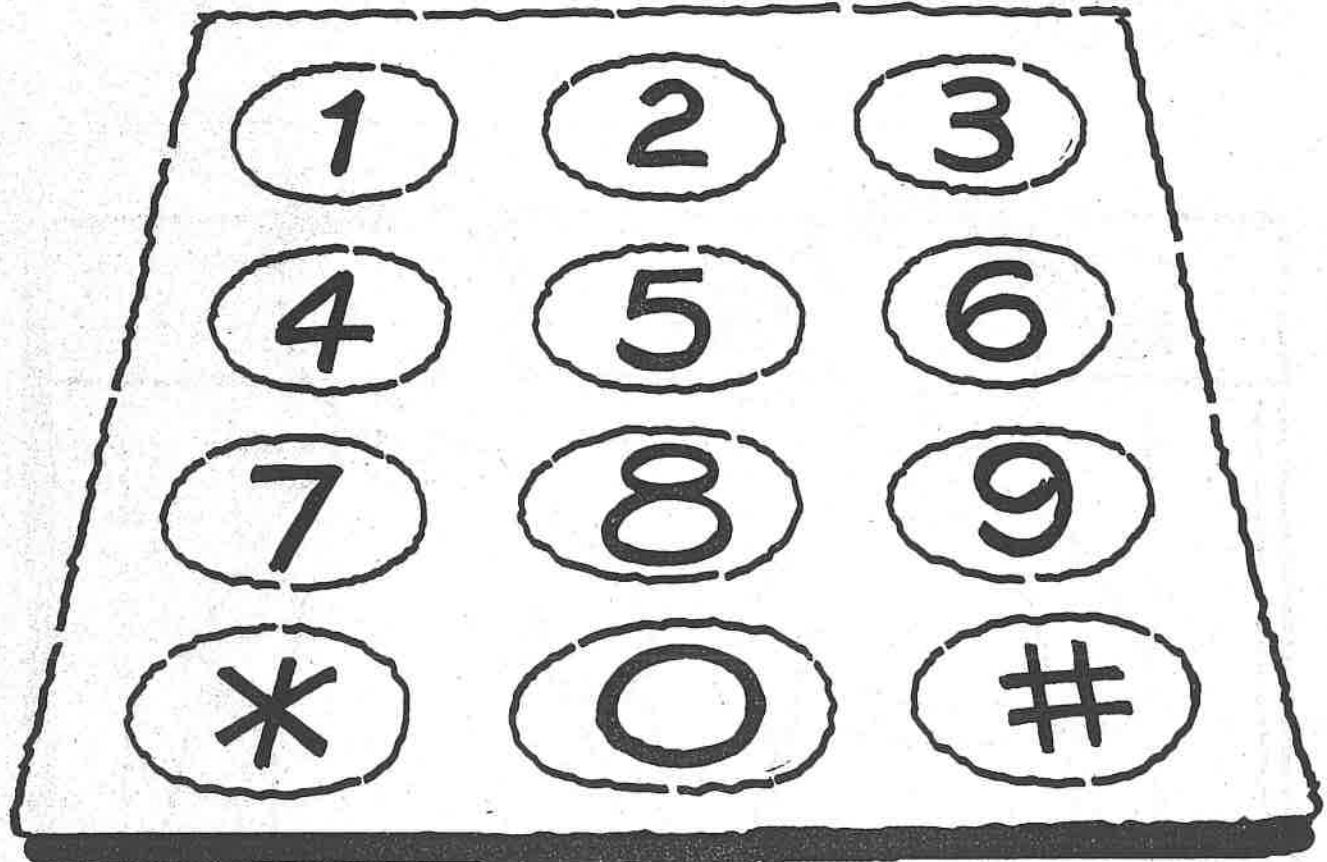

SAFETY FUN

Color the numbers 9 and 1 with a red crayon. Then practice pressing the numbers in order. First 9, then 1, then 1 again.



1. CALL 9-1-1 ON THE PHONE IF THERE IS AN EMERGENCY.
2. TELL THE PERSON WHO ANSWERS WHY YOU ARE CALLING.
3. BE PREPARED TO GIVE YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, AND PHONE NUMBER. SPEAK CLEARLY.
4. DON'T HANG UP UNTIL THE OTHER PERSON TELLS YOU TO.
