What you can turn in :

- Controlled substance medications
- Non-controlled substance (Rx) medications
- Over-the-counter medications
- Medication samples
- Vitamins



What you **CANNOT** turn in:

- Liquid medication
- Needles, syringes, or lancets
- Thermometers and batteries
- Disposable medical waste items such as IV bags, used bandages, gowns, or bio-hazardous items
- Aerosol cans
- Chemicals or disinfectants such as hydrogen peroxide
- Personal care products such as shampoo and soap

Keep Prescription Drugs Secure

- Lock up medication in a secure location and control access.
- Take inventory of all prescription and over-the-counter drugs.
- Keep track of refills.
- Dispose of unused or expired prescriptions in a drug drop box.
- Inform family and friends to safeguard their prescription drugs.
