# **Pedestrian Safety Tips for Euclid**

Lake Shore Boulevard and Euclid Avenue are both five-lane, hightraffic roads which are especially dangerous. Please remember these tips for crossing streets.

- Always cross the street at a traffic signal
- Use crosswalks and stay within the marked lane
- Follow all signs and signals
- Wait for cars to stop
- Wait for the walk signal before stepping into the street
- Look both ways before entering the street
- Make sure traffic has stopped before entering the street
- Keep looking for oncoming vehicles as you cross each lane
- Use good judgment when crossing the street
- Wear bright or reflective clothing at night to be seen better

### CITY OF EUCLID ORDINANACES for pedestrians

#### **315.01 DUTY OF PEDESTRIANS**

(b) No pedestrian shall suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle which is so close as to constitute an immediate hazard.

## 315.03 RIGHT-OF-WAY YIELDED BY PEDESTRIAN; CROSSING ROADWAYS

(a) Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway.

#### 315.05 WALKING ON SIDE-WALKS, STREETS AND EX-PRESSWAYS

(a) Where a sidewalk is provided and its use is practicable, it shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon an adjacent roadway.

Failure to follow these ordinances may result in a citation being issued to the pedestrian.



#### Pedestrian Do's

- Be an example for children and cross only at crosswalks
- Hold hands with children while crossing the street
- Use sidewalks and cross at traffic signals
- Encourage everyone to follow safety rules
- Thank drivers with a friendly wave
- Be safe and seen
- Be cautious and careful

#### Pedestrian Don'ts

- Jaywalk
- Run through traffic
- Walk in the street
- Use headphones or ear buds
- Take risks
