LOBBY, OFFICE AND HALL AREA

AM or PM

Clean sinks and toilets (replace paper products, as needed).

Put away all donations in lobby.

Sweep and vacuum all floors.

Mop floors using $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of Sanso and hot water. Rinse and wring out mop as tight as you can before putting away.

Empty all trash containers.

Use 33 gal. in office, kitchen and utility room.

Use 13 gal. in bathrooms.

Use 55 gal. in kennel.

Wash all soiled blankets and towels. Shake off all debris. Do not overload washer.

Wipe down counter and shelf areas.

Clean inside and outside of glass doors.

KENNEL AREA AM

Put dogs in outside kennels and close chutes.

Remove everything from cages and clean, if necessary.

Let dogs back in and feed them.

Let dogs back out and remove food dishes.

Take drain covers off in 4, 10 and 16, and hose down drain.
Replace drain covers.

Put everything back in cage using clean blankets,
where needed, and clean water bowls.

Let dogs in and close chutes.

Remove drain covers. Hose and squeegee outside kennels.
Replace drain covers.

Wash all dirty food and water bowls.

Wash and dry all dirty laundry.

KENNEL AREA PM

Let dogs out and close chutes.

Make sure bed area is clean. Hose and squeegee, if needed, and give fresh water.

Remove all food from all cages.

Let dogs back in and close them in.

Remove drain covers.

Summer – Hose and squeegee outside kennels.

Winter – Go outside and scoop, where needed - then empty into drain and put bucket of water on top to flush. Hose and squeegee if low temperature will stay above 32 degrees. Use towel to dry if there is a chance ice might form.

Replace drain covers.

Make sure you lock outside kennel gates, and brown and orange doors.

CLEANING THE CAT ROOM

1. Put disinfectant in a bucket of hot water and bring a bucket of clear hot water to cat room.
2. Clean one cage at a time.
 - a. Remove litter box and clean it.
 - b. Remove any toys and dishes.
 - c. Throw away remaining food and water.
 - d. Wipe down all trays and cages using Rescue wipes.
 - e. Remove trays and wash them.
 - f. Put **clean** ceramic bowls of fresh food and water in far corners of cages.
3. Replace litter in floor boxes.
4. Wipe off tops of cages.
5. Wipe off carts.
6. Clean fur off of scratching posts and condos.
7. Mop floor and allow to dry before replacing beds, toys, etc.
8. Wash pooper scoopers when finished.
9. Take out trash to dumpster.

**DO NOT BLOCK EMERGENCY EXIT DOOR
OR LEFT SIDE OF DOUBLE DOORS**

CAT ROOM CLEANING PM

Clean same as AM. Also turn off light and lock door.

OTHER VOLUNTEER DUTIES

Kitchen Area

Wash, dry and put away all dishes.

Everywhere

Empty all trash cans, replace bags and put in dumpster.

Anytime Duties

Clean both yards

Straighten reading materials and hand outs, and replenish.

Exercise and socialize dogs.

Fold and put away laundry.

Socialize cats.
